

## **New NYePay Login Instructions for Adoption Subsidy**

You will need a NY.gov ID to access NYePay and create an account. An NY.gov ID account provides secure electronic access to these services.

Many government services are now available online. Just a few examples: MyDMV, Tax Online Services, Unemployment Benefits etc.

Having a NY.gov ID account means only one user ID/password to remember, and being able to access participating online services anywhere, anytime.

The NY.gov ID Program protects you against unauthorized access to your information as well as the use of technology, policies, and a network of support to prevent unauthorized access to confidential information.

If you do not have a NY.gov ID, you will need to create a personal NY.gov ID before signing up for NYePay. Please follow the steps below to create your NY.gov ID account.





## 4. NY.Gov ID linking:

1. If you already have a NY.Gov ID, you need to link it for NYePay. Enter the NY.Gov ID you wish to link, an email associated with your NY.Gov ID and phone number, and click Submit button.


